

Water Quality Monitoring After Road Construction

Changing the landscape changes what flows into our lake, so BLIA volunteers (Bruce Johnson & Steve Souder) collect water samples in plastic jars with lids with holes in them after significant rainfalls.

The samples are taken to A.W. Research Laboratories, Inc. (AWRL) in Brainerd for analysis. The goal is to determine the concentration of contaminants entering Bay Lake from the impervious surface of the new road.
