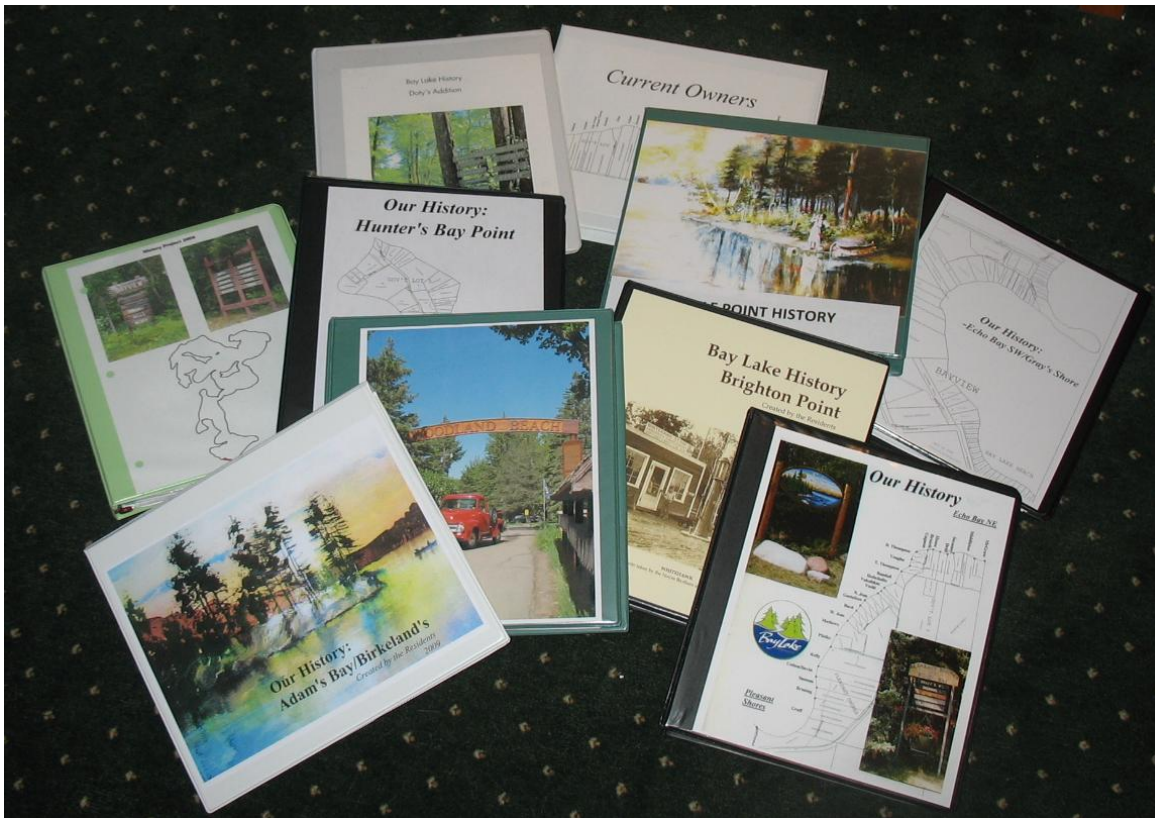


Bay Lake History Project Update - June 2011
